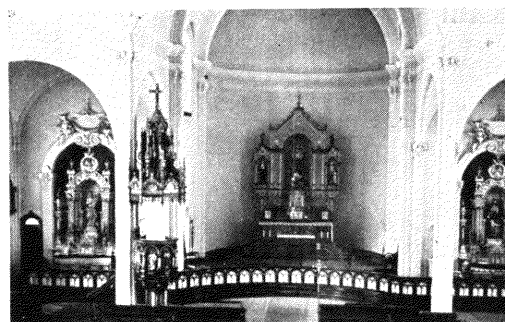

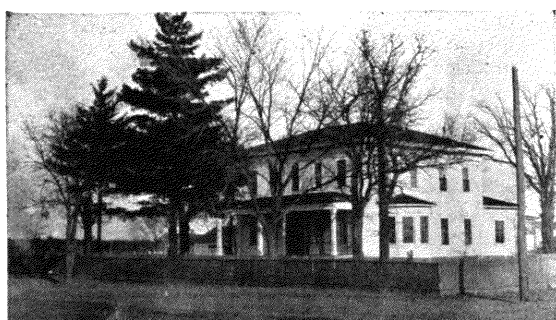
INTERIOR VIEW OF SACRED HEART OF JESUS

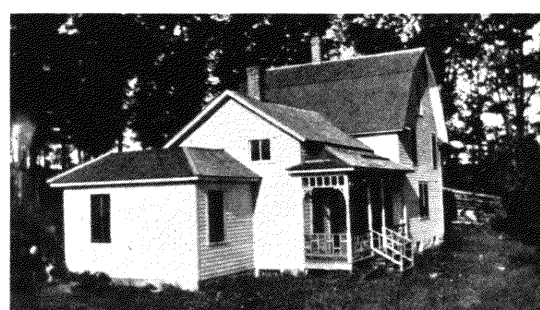

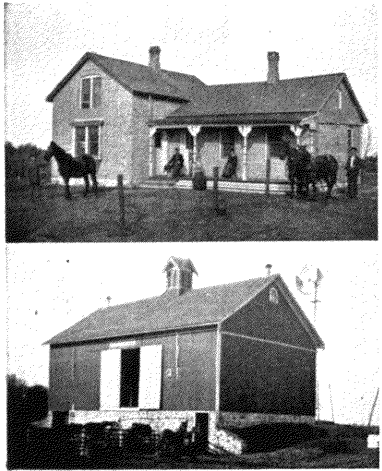

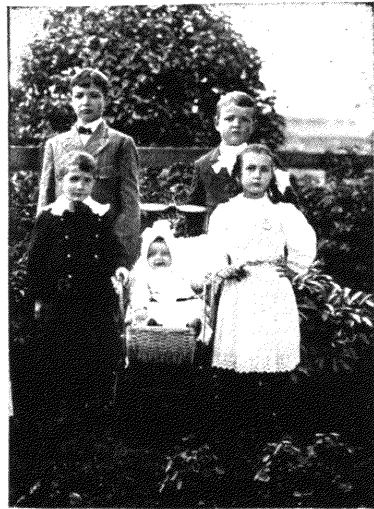

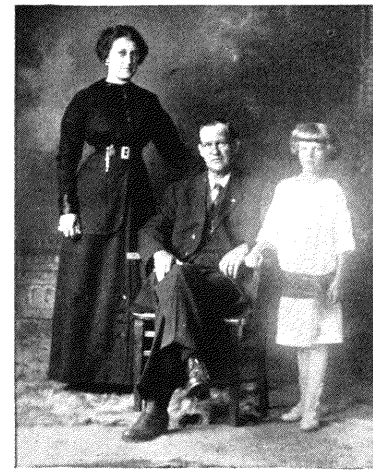

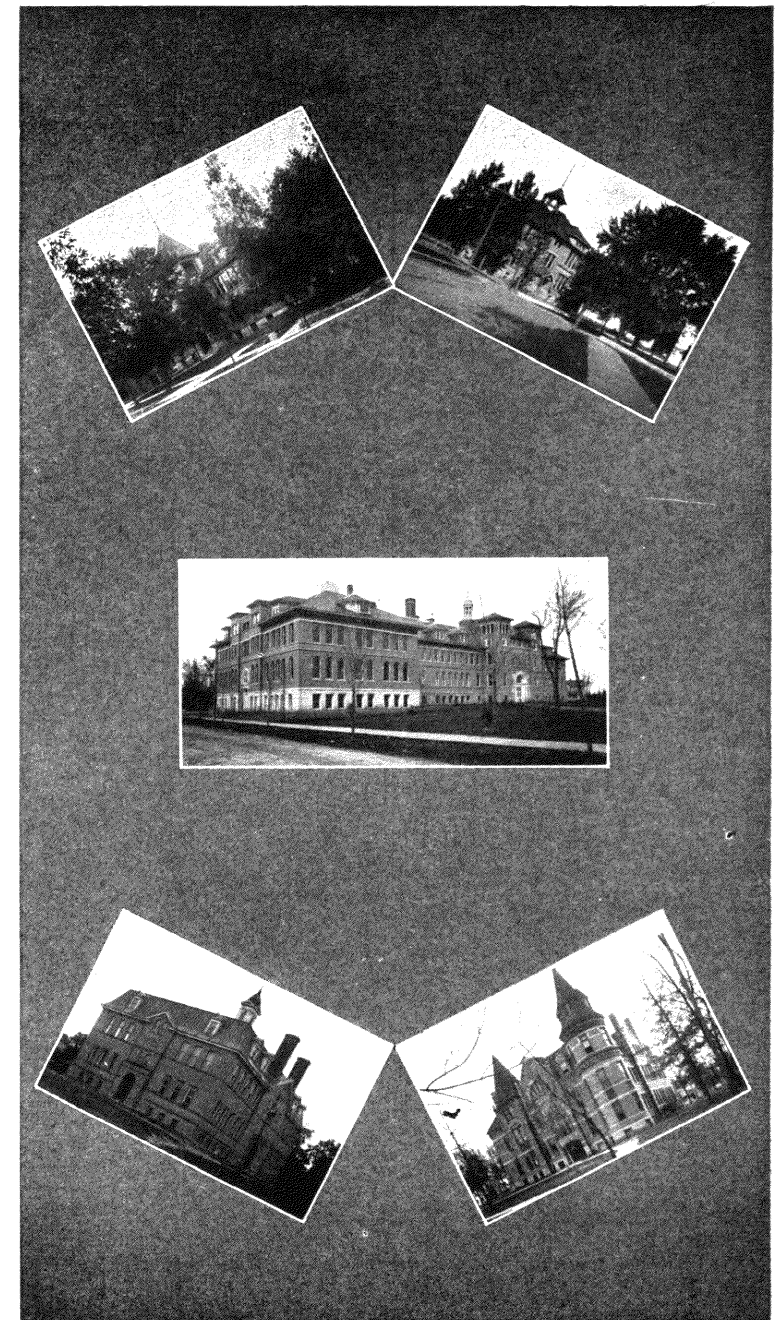

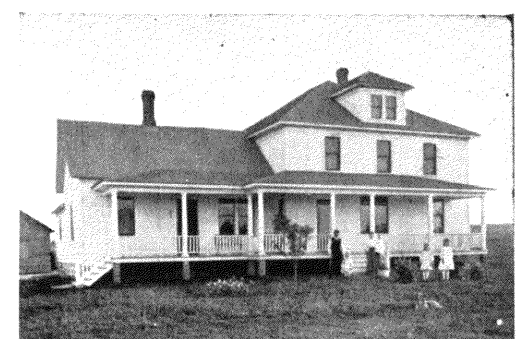

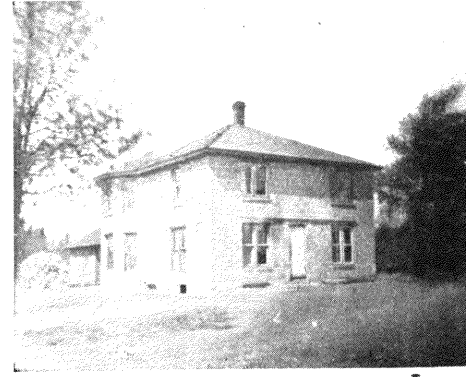

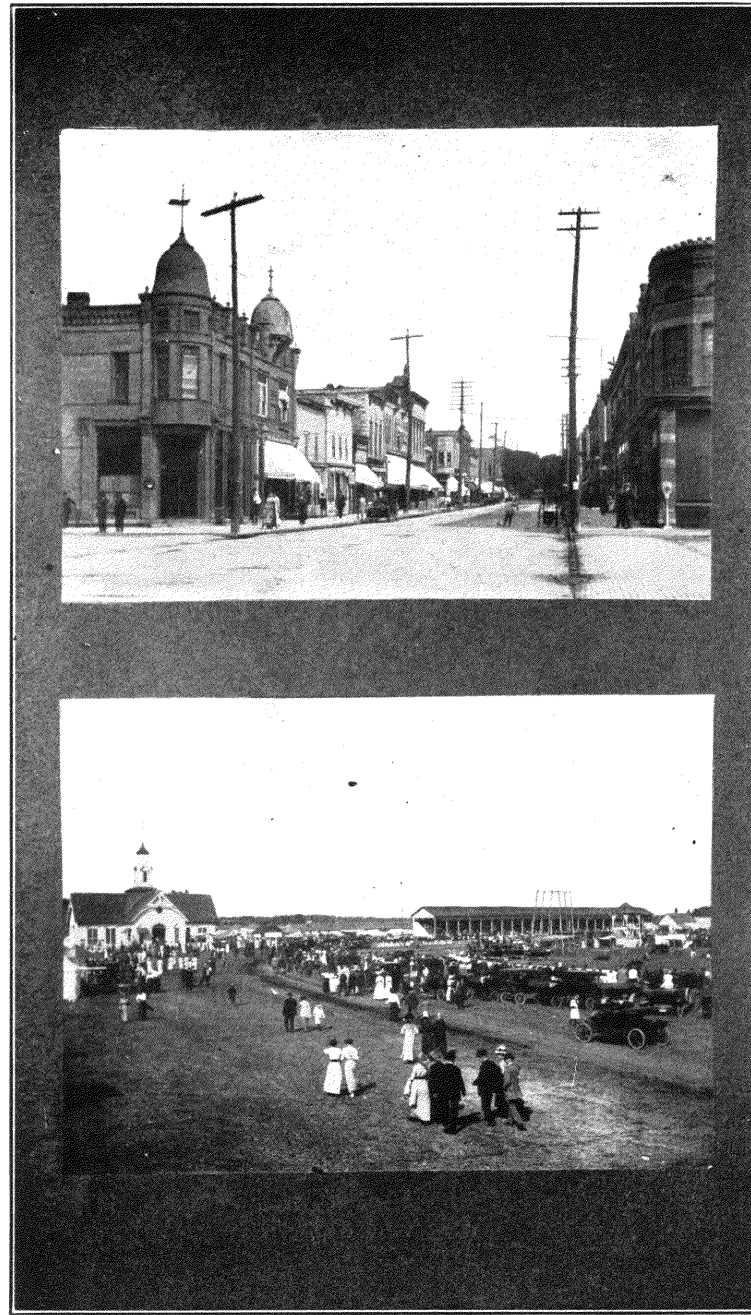

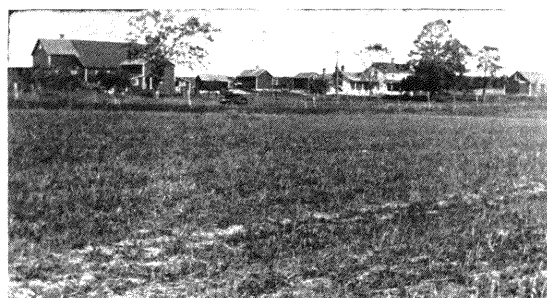
