## Ahmed, Samira - Hollow Fires

YA Ahmed, Fiction\*

After discovering the body of fourteen-year-old Jawad Ali in Jackson Park, seventeen-year-old journalism student Safiya Mirza begins investigating his murder and ends up confronting white supremacy in her own high school.

## Albert, Melissa – Our Crooked Hearts

Told in alternating voices, years after it began, seventeen-year-old Ivy and her mom Dana's shared story comes down to a reckoning among a daughter, a mother, and the dark forces they never should have messed with.

### Hanna Alkaf – Queen of the Tiles


YA Hanna, Fiction\*

# Ireland, Justina – Rust in the Root

YA Ireland, Fiction\*

Laura Ann, a queer Black mystical mage growing up in an alternate 1930s America, is hired to help fix the blight caused by white Mechamancers and discovers she may be key to ending the corruption. Includes historical photographs.

## Jackson, Holly – Five Survive

Red is on a spring break road trip with five friends. When their RV breaks down in the middle of nowhere with no cell service, they realize this is no accident. Someone clearly wants one of them dead, and not all will survive the night.

## Mafi, Tahereh - This Woven Kingdom


