


The Monstrous Misses Mai

Cordi rents a cheap loft in an old building and quickly warms to kindred souls Tessa, Audrey, and Silly. They struggle to eke out a living


until a charming acquaintance of the landlord's offers to fulfill their every dream. All it takes is a small sacrifice.








The Kingdom of Back



A man with a rare condition that has enabled him to survive for centuries moves to London to become a high-school history teacher and considers defying his


protective guardians' rule against falling in love when he becomes entranced by a captivating colleague.
